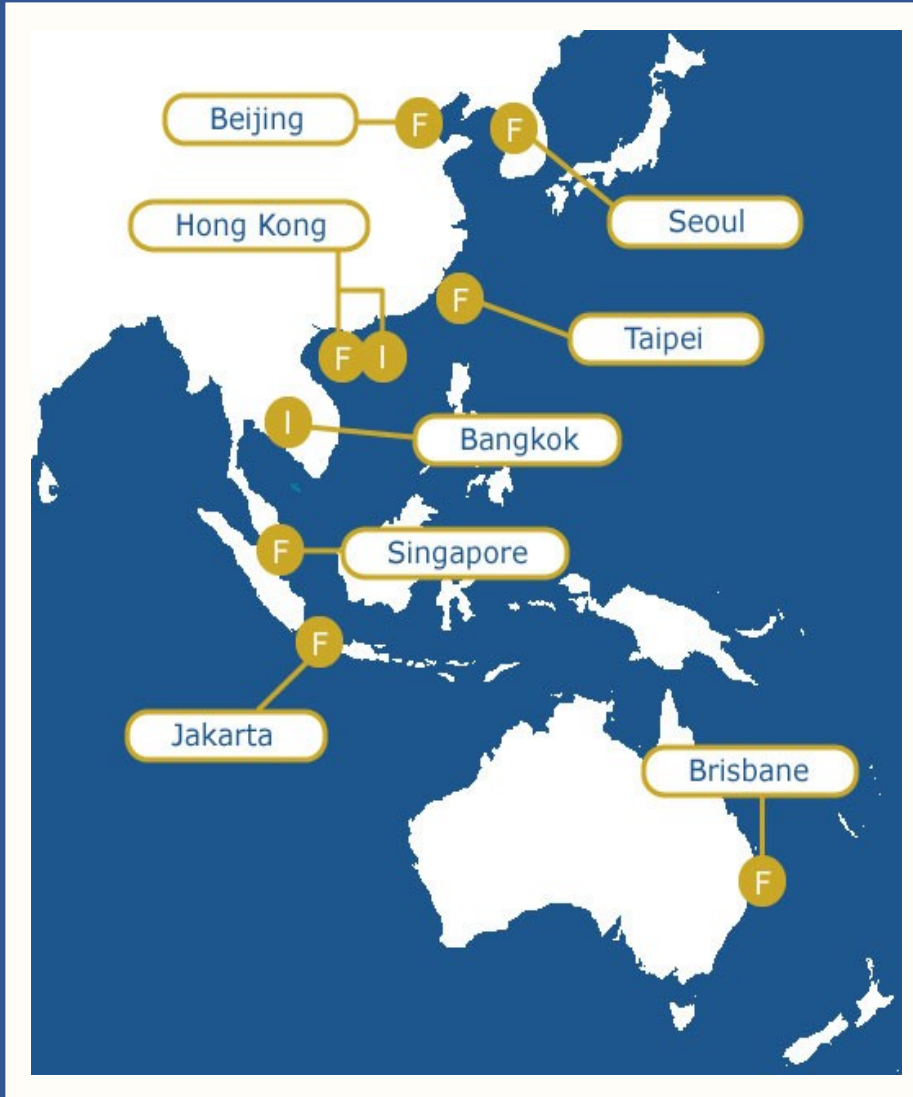
# Member services

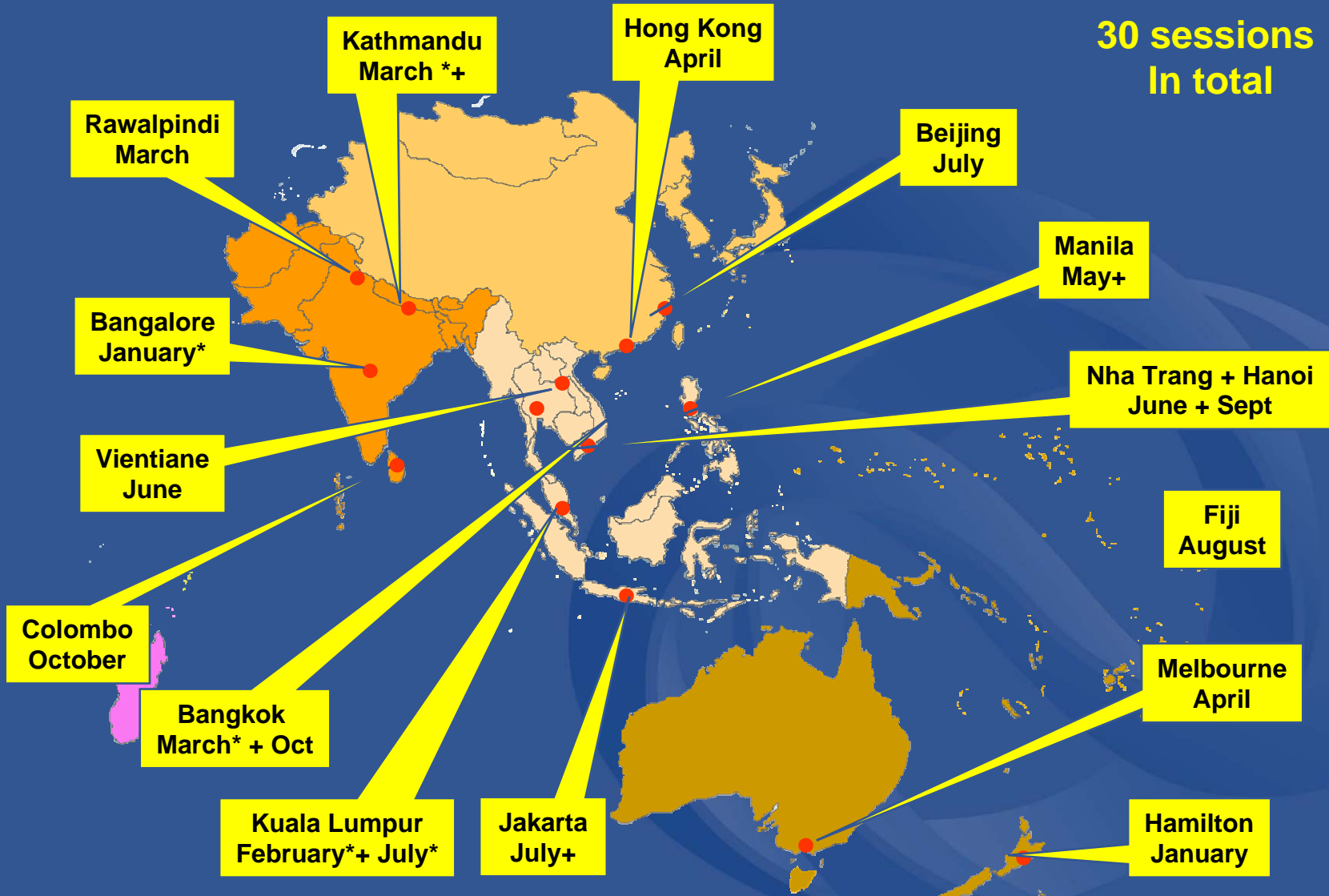
